We would also like to welcome you personally at the Hockenheimring and present our FAUmax Sigma live in action.






Alumni back on track

After 2011 and 2023, the FAUmax delta will be competing again this year at Formula Student Germany in Hockenheim. In 2011, during its actual season, in 2023, on the occasion of the FSG Combustion Reunion, and now again for the 20th anniversary of the German Formula Student event.

Our beloved delta has completed all but two events so far: Hockenheim 2011 and 2023... Therefore, the checkered flag of the Endurance on Sunday afternoon is our big goal! To achieve this, we have worked hard in our workshop, a renovated pigpen, and eliminated known weak points. The wiring of the water pump, which ruined our Endurance in 2023, was professionally replaced. The drive shafts, which repeatedly caused problems two years ago, were also made more robust. Although we are probably the first team in the history of the competition to have replaced its drive shafts in a very short period of time during the Endurance, we would have liked to have avoided it...

The relaxed test day in our beautiful Franconian homeland was characterized above all by the great joy of seeing the other team members "from back then" and, of course, the vehicle. Several drivers were able to get used to the vehicle again after years of inactivity and practice disciplines such as skid pad. After the technical scrutineering on Wednesday, August 20th, skid pad will be the first dynamic discipline for us. Acceleration follows on Friday, autocross on Saturday, before the endurance on Sunday will test our nerves again. However, after a largely problem-free and extensive test drive, we are in good spirits and hope to be able to enjoy the days at the Hockenheimring without any major repairs. After all, with an average age of around 40 years, we are no longer youngsters ;-) Overall, we are looking forward to the event and all the participants on-site! We are eagerly awaiting the very special flair of this competition and the journey back in time to our university days. Many thanks at this point to the organizers of FSG for making this possible for us! We are looking forward to meeting all the teams, especially the other Historic Cup participants, some of whom we last saw 14 years ago. We're also excited to see our current team at the event and are keeping our fingers crossed for them!
